1. Jonata After School/S.Y.H. School Mentoring

- a. Ricky Hernandez, Program Coordinator was unable to attend to share info on the two prevention programs that the Coalition Supports but submitted a letter that was read to inform members of the past semester work.
- b. The Afterschool Program at Jonata for Jr. High at risk youth served 12 students. 6 of the 8th graders participated in graduation with 2 students finishing in summer school. The S.Y.H.S Academic Mentoring program served 20 students all year long and all of the seniors, except one graduated and are scheduled for higher learning in the fall.
- c. The Jonata program will be designed a bit differently for Fall to include a more diverse group of Jr. High Students to allow for some positive peer influence.

2. Social Host Ordinance Update – IT IS OFFICIALLY ON THE BOOKS!

- a. Dean, Policy Chair, shared that the 2nd reading of the SHO was accomplished this AM with a unanimous vote by the Board of Supervisor today to enact the ordinance. It will be in full force and enacted 90 days from its passage.
- b. The County Sheriff has agreed to extend a grace period through November 30, 2010 in order to educate the communities about the new law.
- c. Staff and members will present the ordinance to our cities for adoption in July.
- d. The Task Force will work with the County to design and implement an extensive education campaign.
